2024-2025 Vaccine Clinics

COVID and influenza (FLU) symptoms of fever, aches, and cough can be similar, but the shots to prevent them are different. The US Center for Disease Control (CDC) has recommended COVID and FLU vaccines for <u>all</u> people over 6 months of age. The now annual COVID and FLU vaccines have both been found to be SAFE, EFFECTIVE, and NECESSARY. Know that each of us, our families (children, too), and all of our office staff have also received both the FLU and COVID vaccine in order to protect ourselves....and your children. **Dr. Concannon is on immune suppressant meds, and other of our staff members have their own health concerns as well. Please help <u>protect us</u> by having everyone in your family fully immunized!**

We will be operating our Vaccination Clinics in our office on selected days and times. Of course, if your child is here for a Well Child Visit they may be offered some of these shots at the same time provided we have enough supply. Due to the large number of patients to be given vaccines, please understand that NO other exams or problem discussions can be performed during these special vaccination ONLY visits. No politics here please; these clinics are set up ONLY for those parents who are all on-board with vaccines. If your child is somehow ill at these times, please call to reschedule, as we will not give the shot to a child who is otherwise ill.

Please call us at **943-7337** to schedule a slot in the Vaccine Clinics. Patients over the age of 6 months may be given vaccines by one of our physicians, nurse practitioners, pharmacist, or medical assistants. Due to high clinic numbers we cannot give you a choice of immunization provider. If available, well-children over 2 years may be offered the FluMist nasal spray vaccine in place of the Flu Shot.

For parents and other household members, it is essential that they receive their own adult vaccines as well. Vaccines will be available through your doctor, some public vaccine clinics, and at local pharmacies such as CVS and Walgreens, etc.
